Appendix B. Ground-level photographs of the modern floodplain at two of the nine study sites.



Photograph 1. Ground-level photograph of the inset modern floodplain at site SFR-3 on the unregulated segment of the South Fork Republican River. Bare sediment is visible within the actively disturbed floodplain zone. *Elaeagnus angustifolia* (smaller trees with silvery foliage) and *Populus deltoides* (taller trees with green foliage) occur on the narrowing terrace.



Photograph 2: Ground-level photograph of the inset modern floodplain at site SFR-6 on regulated segment of South Fork Republican River downstream of Bonny Dam. Dense herbaceous vegetation occurs on the floodplain, which is not actively disturbed under the present flow regime. Some *Elaeagnus angustifolia* individuals also occur on the floodplain surface.
